INTRODUCTION

What you have in your hand is the printed version of the message. Read the message, study and meditate on the word of the Lord until you believe it and live it out. The word of the Lord is life and truth.

Jesus Christ our Lord is the way, the truth and the life (John 4:6). He is the word of God that became flesh (John 1:1-18). He came that we may have life, not just life but abundant life and not just abundant life but eternal life (John 10:10; 3:16). The word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Hebrews 4:12)

This is the very reason why the Lord sent His word; He knew that if we fill ourselves with the word, the word will bring life to our mortal bodies. He knew that we shall know the truth (the word of God is truth, *John 17:17*) and the knowledge of the truth shall set us free from the bondage, the torment and the oppression of the evil one *(John 8:32)*.

When Joshua took over from Moses, the Lord told him not to allow the book of the law (the word) to depart from his sight, but to meditate on it day and night in order for him to be prosperous and to have



good success in his assignment (Joshua 1:8,9). The word of God gives strength, courage and brings prosperity and success to your life.

After meditating on the word you must do all that is written in it. James says do not be hearers of the word only, but be doers of the word (*James 1:22*).

Wisdom is the knowledge of the truth and the ability to apply the word you know in any given situation, therefore get wisdom and in your getting, get understanding. (*Proverbs 4:7*).

The Lord gave South Africans the gift of song and dance as a redemptive gift. The Lord gave us these gifts for a purpose; therefore we must seek to know the purpose of the gifts lest we abuse the gift and perish in our ignorance. These gifts are so abundant in our Nation that we turn to take them for granted and not use them to worship the giver of the gift and to bless Nations.

The gifts are a blessing from the Lord, the Lord blesses so that you may be a blessing to the many Nations (Genesis 12:1-3)

The calling upon Vuka Africa Foundation is to be a herald like John the Baptist and to release songs of healing and restoration to create awareness of the time we are living in as a people and as a Continent. No one can deny that a New Africa is rising, and that Africa has the fastest growing economies. This tells you that it is Africa's time; therefore Africa should rise and shine (Isaiah 60:1-3).



As we go we call Africa to arise, to lead and to build Her ruins and Her desolations, and not to miss Her time of visitation and blessing

WORD TREATMENT

Further Instructions on how to do the 100 day treatment:

There are 100 scriptures in this book, take the 100 scriptures everyday for 100 days.

Healing will come through prayer, worship and the word. As mentioned before, the book is a take home.

The Chief Physician has prescribed this treatment for our woundedness, brokenness, hurts, anger, sickness and diseases. The prescription is as follows:

Three pills a day:

One tablet of Hope
One tablet of Healing
One tablet of Restoration

Take this treatment every day for 100 days without breaking.

Read the word aloud, pray and meditate on the word and **ENSURE THAT YOU FINISH THE COURSE**.

The word of God shall heal and deliver you mentally, emotionally, spiritually and physically.

Psalms 107:20 - I sent my word and healed them and delivered them from their destruction.

3 John 1:2 - Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.

Joshua 1:8 - This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

May you experience healing and restoration during this treatment.

VUKA AFRICA CD

The Lord released songs to the Vuka Africa foundation through Apostle Linda Gobodo, which then culminated into the release of the Vuka Africa CD. The songs contained in this CD are songs of hope, healing and restoration, and each song speaks into how the Lord will do this. In no particular order, please see the songs below and the scriptures that have inspired the songs.

Track No 1. You Caused My Past

Genesis 41:50-57; 48:20 (read from verse 13-20 for more understanding): the key for this perpetual blessing is the meaning of the names of the sons of Joseph. Manasseh which means forgetfulness Ephraim meaning fruitfulness. The Lord will make you fruitful in the land of your affliction. Because of this blessing, ask the Lord to cause your past to be forgotten and your future to be fruitful.

Track No 2. Be Still and Know

Psalms 46 (read with Revelations 22:1-5; Ezekiel 47:1-12): which are the founding scriptures for the Healing the Nations Campaign. God has given South Africans the gift of song and dance as redemptive gifts because we are called for the healing of the Nations. We need to be healed first before we can take healing to the Nations that have been waiting for us for the longest time. "Be Still" is not a call for silent worship, it is the voice of God addressing the wicked one who deceives and blinds Nations, with a warning saying It is I God, who will be exalted in victory, you do not have a chance of winning. That makes this song one for warfare: IT IS A WARFARE SONG.

Track No 3. If My People

2 Chronicles 7:10, 14 (read the whole chapter for more understanding.): The people of God are the only ones the Lord will listen to when there are challenges in the Nations. When they repent



God will listen to them and will heal the land, read above scripture with Psalm 85). This song is also a prayer to ask the Lord for revival. When revival comes, the glory of God will be revealed. When people see the glory of the Lord they will believe in Him and will follow Him.

Track No 4. Stand Still

2 Chronicles 20:14-17 (read the whole chapter): When Jehoshaphat was facing war against three Nations he fasted and prayed to God and the whole Nation with him. The Lord answered their prayer and told them they will not fight for this battle is the Lords who is present with them. Jehoshaphat put the singers in front to go to war and as they worshiped the Lord destroyed their enemies and gave them the spoils. This confirms the power of true worship: it unlocks wealth and brings healing. This is another war song. The war is on and the war is the war of God's presence and the war of the revelation of God's glory. The enemy does not want people to see God's presence and His glory because He knows that He will lose them and they will follow the Lord.

Track 5: Be Ready

Revelation 19:11-16. This is a song of declaration of the second coming of the Lord. Nations must be ready because the Lord is coming to judge the world.

Track 6: Send Rain

Job 38:9, 26, and 34; (read the whole chapter and know who God is). He created all things; therefore we should worship the God. We know such worship will cause the Lord to come and dwell with us and to establish His throne here on earth. Other scriptures: 1 Kings 18:1, 44, 45; Ecclesiastes 11:3; Zechariah 10:1. This song is a prayer for revival.



Track 7: All the Host of Heaven

Revelation 4, 5; these two chapters reveal to us the worship that goes on in heaven day and night. They are scriptures of worship. The Lord sits on His throne and is worshiped day and night. David understood this; hence He established a tabernacle and appointed worshippers to worship the Lord so that His presence remains with them (called the tabernacle of David see 1 Chronicles 16).

Track 8: The Lord will Restore

Jeremiah 29:10-14; 33:6-14 (read Jeremiah 31-33); Ezekiel 34:23-31; 36. This is a promise of restoration from the Lord. There is a condition to it though, if you seek the Lord with all your heart He will visit you and will reveal your destiny or the destiny of your Nation. When He comes He will restore you.

Track 9&10: Africa Arise and Lead

Isaiah 60: The Lord told me to release the word over Nation and the song is the Vuka Africa theme song on which the vision is based. The founding Scriptures of Vuka Africa are the following: Isaiah 49:8, 9; 58:12; 60; 61:4; Amos 5:21 24; 9:14; Nehemiah 2:17-20.

The people the Lord is sending the foundation to, have been oppressed for so long such that even though they are liberated now they don't believe their circumstance will ever change. He is sending us to declare and to herald that He will restore them. So we are crying out to the Lord restore, restore - *Isaiah 42:22*.



The Lord also said we must also sing the hymns from the Methodist Hymn book because though the songs were written in the 1800s they were inspired by the Holy Spirit and they have been used for public worship ever since irrespective of denomination.

The songs He gave us are revealing the power of the word of God - Hymn no 114 & 118 and No 116 which was specifically written by Tiyo Soga as a prayer, asking God to remember His covenant.

"Nkosi Sikelela iAfrika" was composed by Enoch Sontonga in 1897 as a prayer to God to bless Africa and to pour down His spirit. The song became the anthem of the oppressed in South Africa. Though we were separated from the rest of the Continent the Lord made us to pray for Africa because He has called us to take the Continent to Her destiny. Now is the time for South Africa to fulfil Her divine prophetic destiny. This prayer became an anthem of a few Nations in Africa.

After 1994 the New South Africa took parts of this song in new national Anthem and left out the part that invited the Holy Spirit to come. The Lord told us to sing the original 'Nkosi Sikelela iAfrika' as a Prayer for Africa saying, He has not changed His mind regarding SA's call to pray for Africa through the words of this song.

Put into practice what you learned from me, what you heard and saw and realized.

The wicked is banished in his wickedness, but the righteous has a refuge in his death.

RESTORATION: GENESIS 6:3

Day 97:
(All scriptures are from the Amplified Version (AMP))

HOPE: PSALM 32:1 - 11

Blessedness of Forgiveness and of Trust in God.

Blessed [fortunate, prosperous, favoured by God] is he whose transgression is forgiven, and whose sin is covered. ² Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute wickedness, And in whose spirit there is no deceit.

³When I kept silent *about my sin*, my body wasted away through my groaning all the day long. ⁴ For day and night Your hand [of displeasure] was heavy upon me; My energy (vitality, strength) was drained away as with the burning heat of summer. *Selah*.

⁵I acknowledged my sin to You, and I did not hide my wickedness; I said, "I will confess [all] my transgressions to the LORD"; And You forgave the guilt of my sin. *Selah.* ⁶ Therefore, let everyone who is godly pray to You [for forgiveness] in a time when You [are near and] may be found; Surely when the great waters [of trial and distressing times] overflow they will not reach [the spirit in] him.

⁷You are my hiding place; You, LORD, protect me from trouble; you surround me with songs *and* shouts of deliverance. *Selah*. ⁸ I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you [who are willing to learn] with



My eye upon you. ⁹ Do not be like the horse or like the mule which have no understanding, whose trappings include bridle and rein to hold them in check, *Otherwise* they will not come near to you.

¹⁰Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but he who trusts in *and* relies on the LORD shall be surrounded with compassion *and* lovingkindness. ¹¹ Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, you righteous [who actively seek right standing with Him]; Shout for joy, all you upright in heart.

HEALING: MATTHEW 28:1 - 20

Jesus Is Risen!

Now after the Sabbath, near dawn of the first *day* of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb. ² And a great earthquake had occurred, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone [from the opening of the tomb], and sat on it. ³ The an-gel's appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were as white as snow. ⁴ The guards shook, paralyzed with fear [at the sight] of him and became like dead men [pale and immobile].

⁵But the angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified. ⁶ He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said [He would]. Come! See the place where He was lying. ⁷ Then go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen from the dead; and behold, He is going ahead of you into Galilee [as He promised]. There you will see Him; behold, I have told you."

⁸ So the women left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy, and ran to tell [the good news to] the disciples. ⁹ And as they went, suddenly, Jesus met them, saying, "Rejoice!" And they went to Him and took hold of His feet [in homage] and worshiped Him [as the Messiah]. ¹⁰ Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell My brothers to leave for Galilee, and there they will see Me [just as I promised]."

¹¹While they were on their way, some of the [Roman] guards went into the city and reported to the chief priests everything that had happened. ¹² And when the chief priests had gathered with the elders and had consulted to-gether [to develop a plan of deception], they gave a sufficient sum of money



[as a bribe] to the soldiers, ¹³ and said, "You say this, 'His disciples came at night and stole Him while we were sleeping.' ¹⁴ And if the governor (Pilate) hears about it, we will calm him down and keep you out of trouble." ¹⁵ So they took the money [they were paid for lying] and did as they were instructed; and this [fabricated] story was widely spread among the Jews, and is to the present day.

The Great Commission

¹⁶Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had designated. ¹⁷ And when they saw Him, they worshiped *Him*; but some doubted [that it was really He]. ¹⁸ Jesus came up and said to them, "All au-thority (all power of absolute rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to

Me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations [help the people to learn of Me, believe in Me, and obey My words], baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always [remain-ing with you perpetually—regardless of circumstance, and on every occa-sion], even to the end of the age."

RESTORATION: EZRA 3:1 – 8 Altar and Sacrifices Restored

When the seventh month came and the sons of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered together as one man to Jerusalem. ² Then Jeshua the son of Jozadak and his brothers the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and his brothers arose, and they built the altar of the God of Israel, to offer burnt offerings on it, as it is written in the Law of Moses, the man of God. ³ So they set up the altar on its [old] foundation, for they were terrified because of the peoples of the lands; and they offered burnt offerings on it to the LORD, morn-ing and evening.

⁴ They celebrated the Feast of Booths, as it is written, and offered the fixed number of daily burnt offerings, in accordance with the ordinances, as each day required; ⁵ and afterward, there was the continual burnt offering, the offering at the New Moons, and at all the appointed festivals of the LORD that were consecrated, and the offerings of everyone who made a voluntary offering to the LORD. ⁶ From the first day of the seventh month they began to offer



burnt offerings to the LORD, but the foundation of the temple of the LORD had not been laid. ⁷ They gave money to the masons and to the carpenters, and gave food, drink, and [olive] oil to the people from Sidon and Tyre, to bring cedar wood from Lebanon to the seaport of Joppa, in accordance with the authorization they had from Cyrus king of Persia.

Temple Restoration Begun

⁸ In the second year of their coming to God's house at Jerusalem, in the sec-
ond month, Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and Jeshua the son of Jozadak
began [the work], with the rest of their brothers—the priests and Levites and
all who came to Jerusalem from the captivity. They appointed the Levites
from twenty years old and upward, to oversee the work of the house of the
Lord.

RESTORATION: 1 SAMUEL 8:1 - 20

Israel Asks for a King

When Samuel grew old, he appointed his sons as Israel's leaders. ² The name of his firstborn was Joel and the name of his second was Abijah, and they served at Beersheba. ³ But his sons did not follow his ways. They turned aside after dishonest gain and accepted bribes and perverted justice. ⁴ So all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah. ⁵ They said to him, "You are old, and your sons do not follow your ways; now appoint

a king to lead[b] us, such as all the other nations have." But when they said, "Give us a king to lead us," this displeased Samuel; so he prayed to the LORD.

⁷And the LORD told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king. ⁸ As they have done from the day I brought them up out of Egypt until this day, forsaking me and serving other gods, so they are doing to you. ⁹ Now listen to them; but warn them solemnly and let them know what the king who will reign over them will claim as his rights."

¹⁰Samuel told all the words of the LORD to the people who were asking him for a king. ¹¹ He said, "This is what the king who will reign over you will claim as his rights: He will take your sons and make them serve with his chariots and horses, and they will run in front of his chariots. ¹² Some he will assign to be commanders of thousands and commanders of fifties, and others to plow his ground and reap his harvest, and still others to make weapons of war and equipment for his chariots. ¹³ He will take your daughters to be perfumers and cooks and bakers.

He will take the best of your fields and vineyards and olive groves and give them to his attendants. ¹⁵ He will take a tenth of your grain and of your vin-tage and give it to his officials and attendants. ¹⁶ Your male and female serv-ants and the best of your cattle [c] and donkeys he will take for his own use. ¹⁷ He will take a tenth of your flocks, and you yourselves will become his



slaves. ¹⁸ When that day comes, you will cry out for relief from the king you have chosen, but the LORD will not answer you in that day."

¹⁹ But the people refused to listen to Samuel. "No!" they said. "We want a king
over us. 20 Then we will be like all the other nations, with a king to lead us and
to go out before us and fight our battles."
DAY 99:

RESTORATION: JOSHUA 9:1-27

Gibeon

- ¹⁻² All the kings west of the Jordan in the hills and foothills and along the Mediterranean seacoast north toward Lebanon—the Hittites, Amorites, Canaanites, Perizzites, Hivites, Girgashites, and Jebusites—got the news. They came together in a coalition to fight against Joshua and Israel under a single command.
- ³⁻⁶ The people of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done to Jericho and Ai and cooked up a ruse. They posed as travellers: their donkeys loaded with patched sacks and mended wineskins, threadbare sandals on their feet, tattered clothes on their bodies, nothing but dry crusts and crumbs for food. They came to Joshua at Gilgal and spoke to the men of Israel, "We've come from a far-off country; make a covenant with us."



⁷The men of Israel said to these Hivites, "How do we know you aren't local people? How could we then make a covenant with you?" ⁸ They said to Joshua, "We'll be your servants." Joshua said, "Who are you now? Where did you come from?"

9-11 They said, "From a far-off country, very far away. Your servants came because we'd heard such great things about God, your God—all those things he did in Egypt! And the two Amorite kings across the Jordan, King Sihon of Heshbon and King Og of Bashan, who ruled in Ashtaroth! Our leaders and everybody else in our country told us, 'Pack up some food for the road and go meet them. Tell them, we're your servants; make a covenant with us.'

12-13 "This bread was warm from the oven when we packed it and left to come and see you. Now look at it—crusts and crumbs. And our cracked and mended wineskins, good as new when we filled them. And our clothes and sandals, in tatters from the long, hard traveling." ¹⁴ The men of Israel looked them over and accepted the evidence. But they didn't ask GoD about it. ¹⁵ So Joshua made peace with them and formalized it with a covenant to guarantee their lives. The leaders of the congregation swore to it.

16-18 And then, three days after making this covenant, they learned that they were next-door neighbours who had been living there all along! The People of Israel broke camp and set out; three days later they reached their towns—Gibeon, Kephirah, Beeroth, and Kiriath Jearim. But the People of Israel didn't attack them; the leaders of the congregation had given their word before the God of Israel. But the congregation was up in arms over their leaders.

19-21 The leaders were united in their response to the congregation: "We prom-ised them in the presence of the God of Israel. We can't lay a hand on them now. But we can do this: We will let them live so we don't get blamed for breaking our promise." Then the leaders continued, "We'll let them live, but they will be woodcutters and water carriers for the entire congregation." And that's what happened; the leaders' promise was kept.

22-23 But Joshua called the Gibeonites together and said, "Why did you lie to us, telling us, 'We live far, far away from you,' when you're our next-door neighbours? For that you are cursed. From now on its menial labour for you—woodcutters and water carriers for the house of my God."

24-25 They answered Joshua, "We got the message loud and clear that GoD, your God, commanded through his servant Moses: to give you the whole country and destroy everyone living in it. We were terrified because of you; that's



why we	did	this.	That's	it.	We're	at your	mercy.	Whateve	er you	decide	is	right
for us,	do it	."										

26-27 And that's what they did. Joshua delivered them from the power of the
People of Israel so they didn't kill them. But he made them woodcutters and water carriers for the congregation and for the Altar of God at the place God chooses. They still are.
