# Prayer Points for Chief Justice Mogoeng Mogoeng 1-3 July 2020

#### 1. Psalm 18:1-3

"I will love You, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I trust; my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised; so shall I be saved from my enemies."

Pray that as the Chief Justice loves the Lord His God and has made this known to all people, that the Lord would be for him:

- His strength, His rock and fortress, His deliverer, His shield, The horn of His salvation and His stronghold
- And that as he together with us call upon the Lord he and his family will be saved from his enemies

## 2. Psalm 31:20

"You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the plots of man! You shall keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues."

## Pray that the Lord would:

- Hide the Chief Justice and his family in the secret place of His presence from the plots of men.
- Keep them in His secret pavilion from the strife of tongues

#### 3. Isaiah 41:10-15 - verses 10 & 15

"Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.......Behold, I will make you into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; you shall thresh the mountains and beat them small, and make the hills like chaff."

## **Pray that the Chief Justice would**

- Be conscious of God's presence and not be afraid or dismayed by what man does or says
- Be upheld by the righteous right hand of God
- Become a sharp threshing sledge to thresh the mountains that come against him to challenge his faith and purpose in God

## 4. Isaiah 54:17

"No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me, says the Lord."

## **Pray for the Chief Justice that**

- No weapon formed against him or his family would prosper
- Every tongue raised to judge him would be condemned
- His righteousness as a servant of God in Christ would shine forth

## 5.Psalm 122:6

"Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: may they prosper who love you."
